**Exams offered by the School**

Special Identification Card (SPID) and Fumigation exams will be offered on Saturday, November 18. Students interested should complete and submit an exam application along with the required fees to the Florida Department of Agriculture & Consumer Services (DACs) before October 10, 2006. **Exam Preparation**

Most of the material on the certification exams will be covered throughout the course. Also available and recommended is the exam review session (nominal fee \$25) to be held on November 17 from 2-5 p.m. When registering, be sure to request the review session.

**Continuing Education Units (CEUs)**

Upon completion of the course, certified operators and SPIDs can receive up to 6 CEUs (2 Core, 2 Termite, 2 Fumigation). A Certificate of Completion and a copy of the program agenda are given at the end of the course. To apply for CEUs from your state, contact your state's licensing office.
