

POSTER DISPLAY INSTRUCTIONS

The Wildland-Urban Interface: Sustaining Forests in a Changing Landscape

November 5-8, 2001 • Gainesville, Florida

POSTER PARTICIPANTS:

The Wildland-Urban Interface Conference invites you to present posters focusing on innovative ideas and programs for sustaining forests at the interface.

POSTER SPECIFICATIONS:

Posters are limited to a space 4 feet high x 8 feet wide. Poster boards will be freestanding and they will accommodate one poster on each side. Allow a 4-inch x 4-inch space for a poster number in the upper left-hand corner of your poster. Displays may be affixed using **PUSHPINS or VELCRO only**. You may want to bring some with you, as only a limited supply will be available on-site. The use of tape is **NOT** permitted.

POSTER SET-UP & REMOVAL TIMES:

Poster boards will be assembled in the hotel's prefunction area of the Conference Center. Poster displays can be set-up from 6:00pm – 8:00pm on Sunday, November 4, 2001 and from 9:00am – 5:00pm on Monday, November 5, 2001.

Poster displays MUST be set up by 5:00pm on Monday, November 5 and be removed by 10:00pm on Wednesday, November 7. The conference is not responsible for the loss of or damage to poster displays not taken down by 10:00pm on Wednesday, at which time the boards will be dismantled and removed from the hotel.

POSTER DISPLAY TIME & FORMAL POSTER SESSION:

The posters will be readily accessible to conference participants during lunch and refreshment breaks throughout the conference. A Poster Reception is scheduled from 5:30pm-7:30pm on Monday, November 5.
