Target 2: Maintain and restore ecosystems and their services

By 2020, ecosystems and their services are maintained and enhanced by establishing green infrastructure and restoring at least 15 % of degraded ecosystems

Action 5. "Member States will, with the assistance of the Commission, <u>map and assess</u> the state of ecosystems and their services in their national territory by 2014, <u>assess the economic value of such services</u>, and promote the integration of these values <u>into accounting and reporting systems</u> at EU and national level by 2020."


