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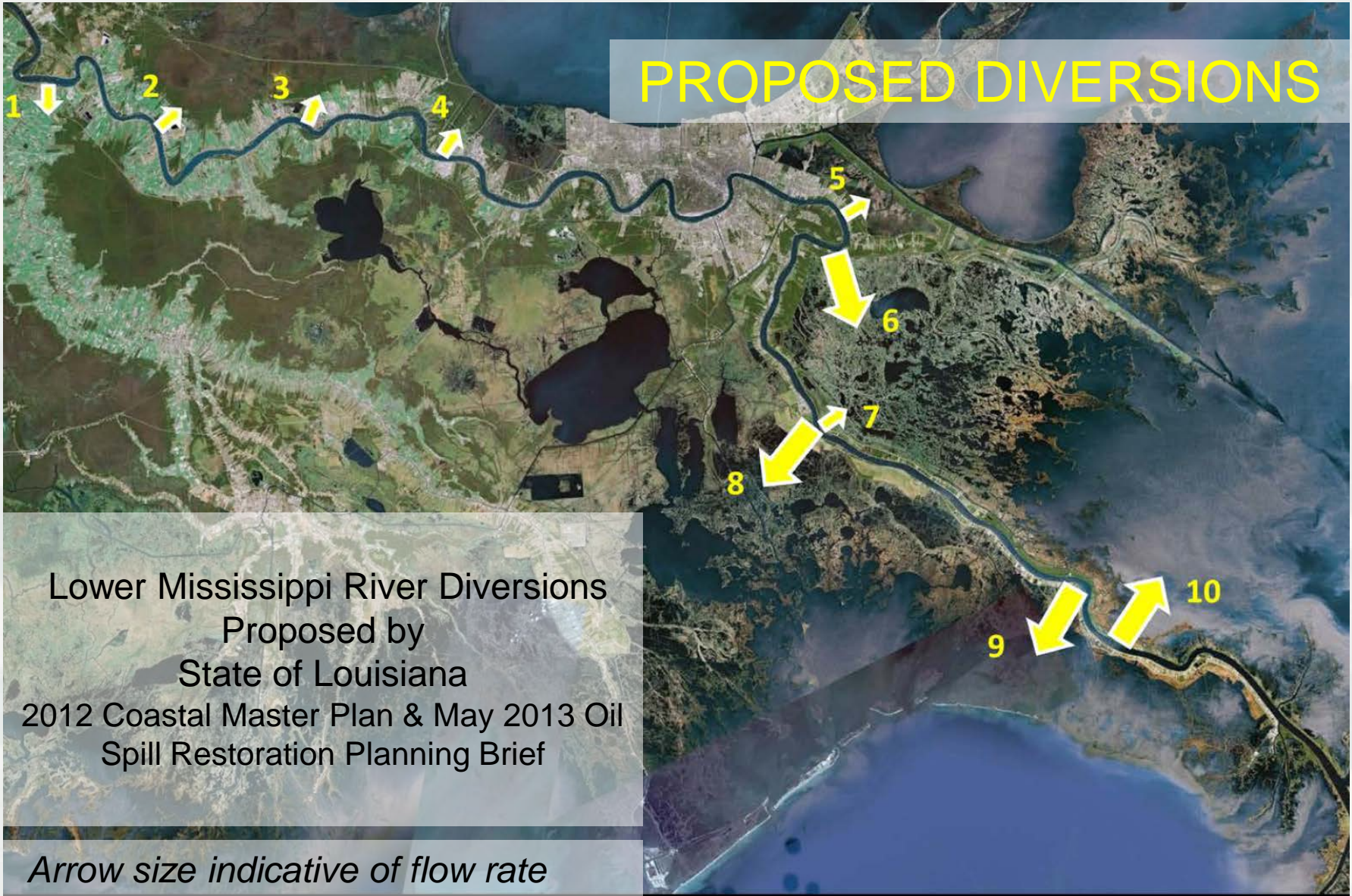
Land Area Change in Coastal Louisiana (1952 to 2010)
