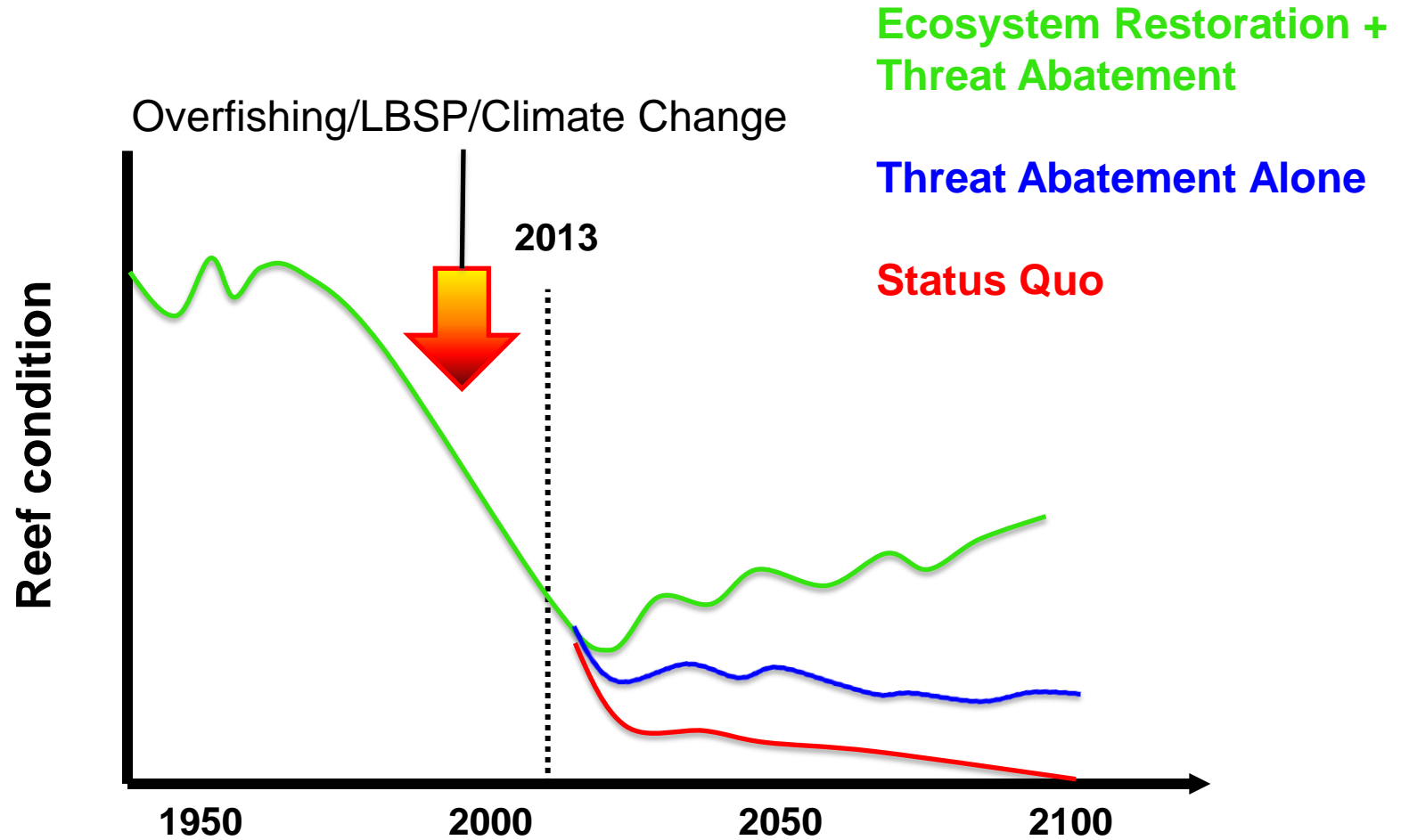

We collect from diverse, wild colonies...



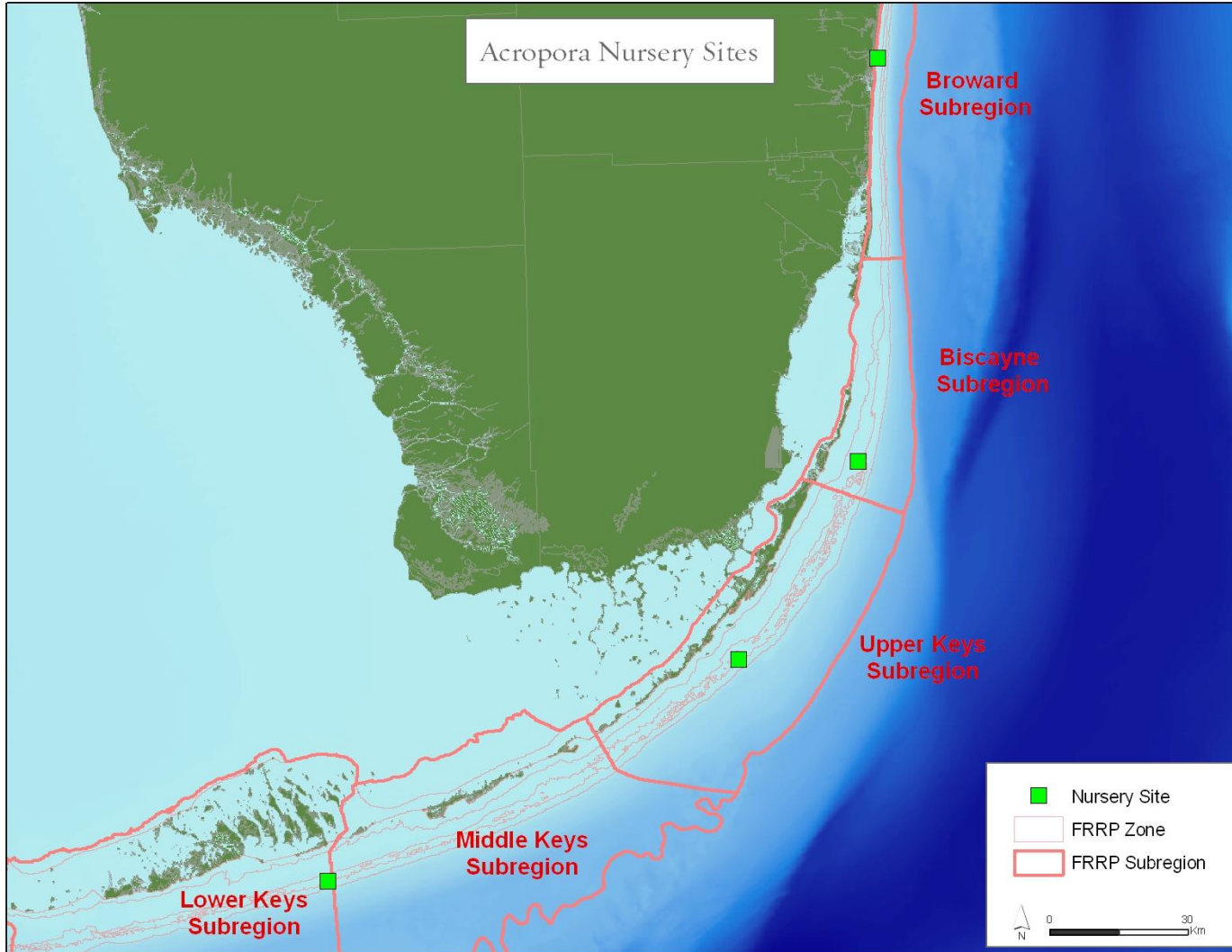
Grow them in coral nurseries...



Then restore breeding colonies to degraded reefs.

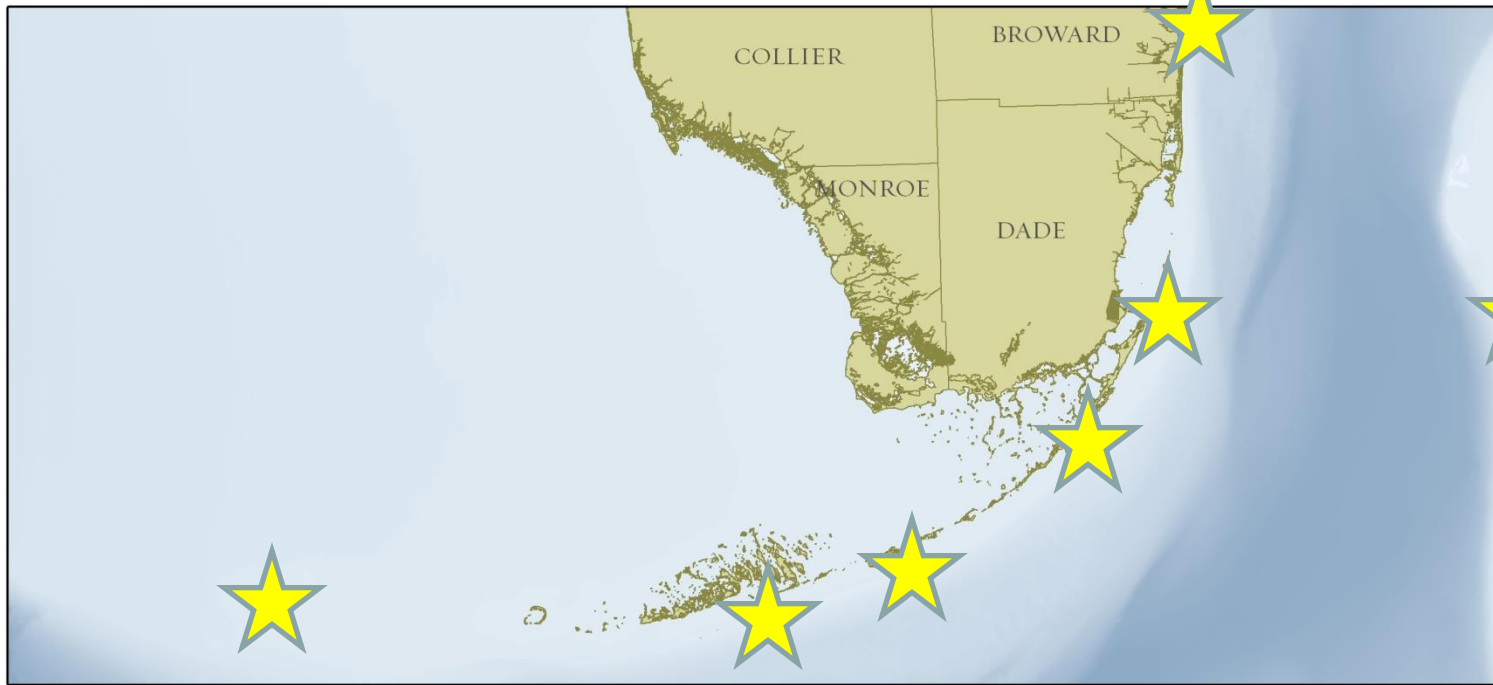
