

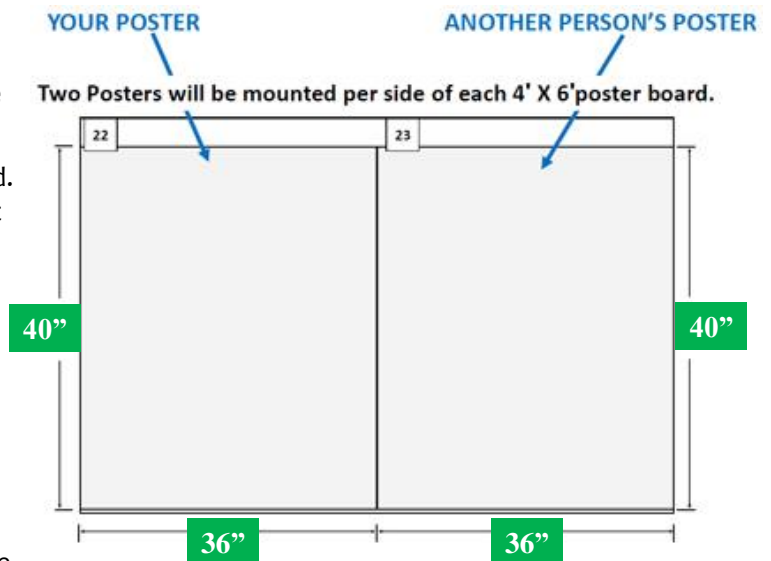
POSTER DISPLAY SPECIFICATIONS

National Conference on Ecosystem Restoration (NCER 2016)

April 18-22, 2016 • Coral Springs, FL

Poster Display Size & Specifications

- Posters will be limited to **40 inches high x 36 inches wide**
- Allow a 4-inch x 4-inch space (10.16cm x 10.16cm) for a poster number in the upper left-hand corner of the board. Each poster will be assigned a number in advance so that you will know where to place your poster.
- You will be sharing the board with another poster presenter. It is imperative your poster not exceed the allowed dimensions.
- Poster boards will be freestanding and contiguously connected to each other.
- Presenters must use the poster boards provided by the Conference.
- Poster boards are covered with fabric, and posters can be affixed using either Velcro or $\frac{3}{4}$ " long push pins. Tape is not permitted. A limited supply of Velcro tape will be available for your use during mounting, but we recommend you bring a supply with you. Multiple two-inch strips work best.

Poster Session I:

POSTER SET UP: Monday, April 18, 3:00pm – 6:00pm (If you arrive after this time, you can set it up during breakfast the next morning.)

POSTER RECEPTION: Tuesday, April 19, 5:00pm-7:00pm (Presenters must be stationed at their posters 6pm-7pm.)*

POSTER REMOVAL: Wednesday, April 20, 10:00am-10:30am (At the end of the AM break)

Poster Session II:

POSTER SET UP: Wednesday, April 20, 12:00pm – 1:00pm (During lunch or before the afternoon session begins.)

POSTER RECEPTION: Thursday, April 21, 5:00pm-7:00pm (Presenters must be stationed at their posters 6pm-7pm.)*

POSTER REMOVAL: Thursday, April 21 (Immediately following the poster session reception.)

Important details to note:

➤ ***Please stand at your poster during the applicable Poster Session Reception as follows:**

- Presenters at ODD NUMBERED BOARDS: 5:30pm - 6:15pm.

- Presenters at EVEN NUMBERED BOARDS: 6:15pm – 7:00pm.

This is the primary opportunity for attendees to meet with you personally and ask questions about your work, so please be available at your poster during the appointed time.
