

Poster Display Specifications

- Posters are on display throughout the conference.
- Posters are portrait style, limited to **46" tall x 36" wide**. *Two posters are placed side-by-side on one board. ***Please do not exceed specified dimensions.****
- Each poster is assigned a number in advance. We number the board. You do not need to place a number on your poster design.

NEW INSTRUCTIONS: Posters must be affixed using pushpins. A supply will be provided. **Velcro will not work.**

- During the formal poster session scheduled Wednesday (5pm–8pm), poster presenters are asked to stand at their board and be available for attendee questions.
