- Wide distribution
- Landscape-scale drivers







Sage-grouse in Oregon

Primary threats:

- Too much fire (annual grasses)
- Too little fire (conifer expansion)

Secondary but significant:

- Energy and other development
- Grazing practices
- Agricultural conversion
