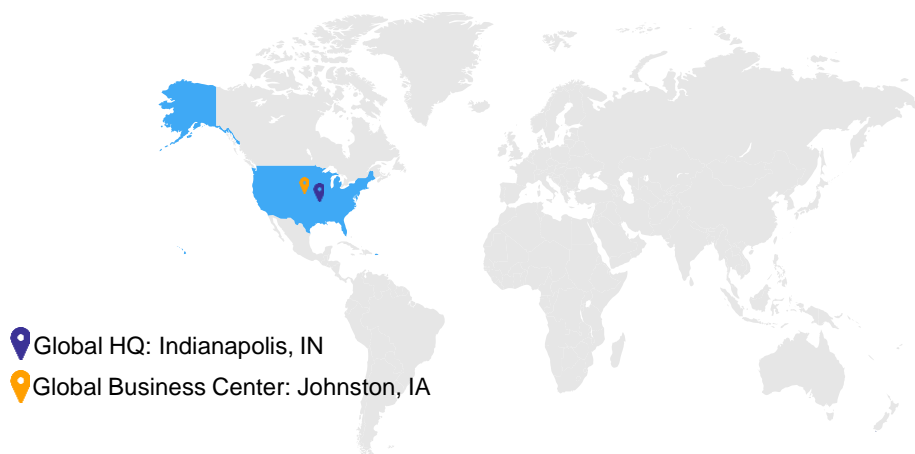

affected over 2.5 million Americans in education, ag safety, disaster recovery, food security and more.

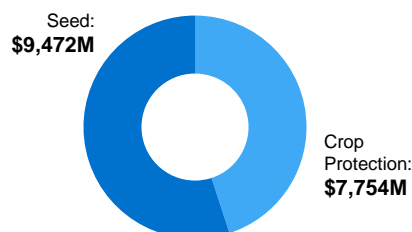
