Exams at Short Course

You MUST have a voucher number to take exams (new or adding)

How to register for pesticide exam voucher number:

1. Go to the FDACS licensing website:
<https://fdescomm.freshfromflorida.com>
2. Click "Agriculture/RUP License Chapter 487" on the home page.
3. Click "Exam Sign-Up". Choose the option "Obtain a New License" or "Add a Category or Recertify for Renewal" that is applicable for you.
4. Select license type that is applicable for you.
5. Continue with the application to apply for an exam(s) and receive the voucher number.
6. Print the confirmation with the voucher number. **You must have this number with you to examine on Friday.** Your cell phone may not be accessible throughout the examination process.

After obtaining your voucher, schedule your exams on the computer:

1. Go to <https://pesticideexam.fva.ufl.edu/scheduleExam> and follow prompts
2. As an attendee of the Short Course, you should select the "Aquatic Weed Short Course 2020" Testing Center
