Wetland biogeochemistry involves cycling or exchange of materials between living and non-living components of an ecosystem. Biogeochemistry is an interdisciplinary science which includes the interaction of biological, geological and chemical processes regulating the fate and transport of nutrients and contaminants in soil, water and atmospheric components of an ecosystem. This international symposium provides a framework for scientists to share technical information on various topics related to coupled biogeochemical cycling of macro-elements and associated organic and inorganic contaminants. The goal is to improve our understanding of the role wetlands and aquatic systems perform in regulating and mitigating impacts of global climate change and sea level rise.

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SPONSOR DISPLAY INFORMATION

A limited amount of space is available for sponsors confirmed at the Silver level and above, to set up table-top displays in the poster display and refreshment break area.

SPONSOR DISPLAY SET-UP & REMOVAL TIMES

MOVE-IN DISPLAYS:	Monday, June 14, 2027	4:00pm–6:00pm
MOVE-OUT DISPLAYS:	Thursday, June 17, 2027	10:00am–10:30am

- Each 6' table comes with a cube of display space **equal to 6' wide by 6' deep**. A three-foot walkway will be maintained between each display.
- Pop-up banners may be used, as long as they fit within the cube of space.
- If you plan to put pop-up banners behind your table, make sure your graphics department knows important content should appear at the top of the banner.
- Additional costs will be incurred should you require electricity for your display.
- Display placement is determined by the organizers. Your table will be identified with a tent card.
- Sponsor tabletop displays will be located in the poster hall, and placed around the perimeter of the room, with attendee seating, posters, and refreshment breaks set up in the remaining space.
- Tabletop displays are meant to serve as a forum to show informational materials, so a representative does not need to remain stationed at the table. If you want to interact with attendees, the times most effective for doing so are during early morning refreshments, daily am and pm breaks, and the evening poster session.
- Individuals assisting with setting up the tabletop display, but not remaining at the conference, do not need to register. Otherwise, all display staff and representatives must be full registrants.
- If you wish to bring informational materials sufficient for everyone, we expect roughly 150-175 people to attend the conference.
- WiFi Internet will be available at no charge. Electricity is not provided.
- Parking is \$20 per vehicle per day. Valet parking is not available. To unload materials, we recommend using the conference center entrance. If you need assistance by a bellman, use the hotel's main entrance.
