Registration Deadline: March 28, 2025


Student poster presentations play a key role in the exchange of information. Considerable time is dedicated to viewing them so researchers, allied industry representatives, and other summit attendees can interact and use these opportunities to share details of their work, successes, and lessons learned. Posters will be on display during dedicated poster viewing times, as well as during specified Networking functions. You will have plenty of time for visibility, networking and interaction with attendees!

Student poster Presenter Registration Deadline: Please register and pay the applicable fee by <u>February 20, 2026,</u> to confirm participation as a poster presenter and secure board space, and to have your abstract published in the abstract book.

Poster Display Specifications

- Posters are limited to 34" wide by 46" high.
 If your poster doesn't fit it will be removed.
- Due to limited space, two poster presentations are mounted to <u>one side</u> of a poster board.
- No tables or electricity will be provided.
- Posters are assigned numbers in advance and boards are labeled. <u>Do not include a number on</u> <u>your poster.</u>
- Poster boards are freestanding and contiguous.
- Velcro will be provided to affix your poster.



There is a 1" metal frame around the perimeter of the board. *Please be kind*. Do not exceed the specified dimensions and overlap or encroach on your neighbor's space.
