Poster Presenter Instructions

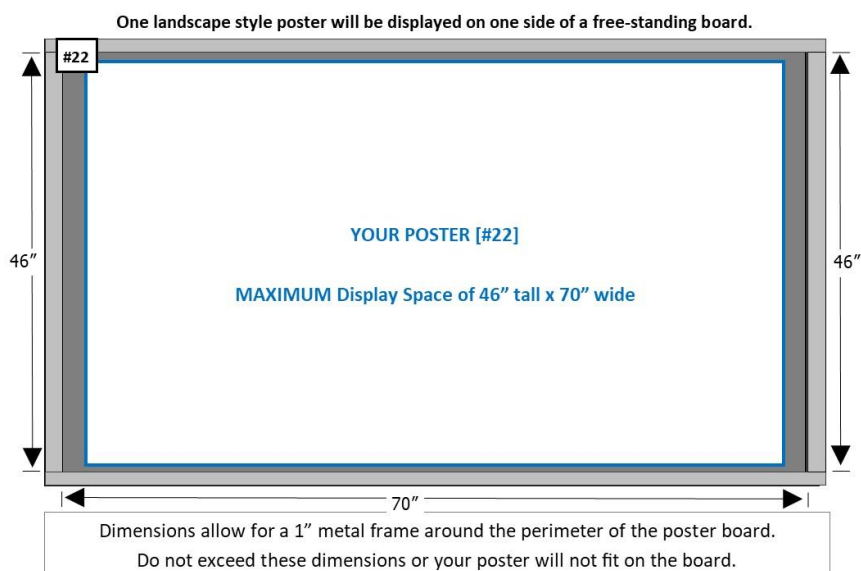
Registration Deadline: August 16, 2024

Poster presentations play a key role in the exchange of information at the Symposium. Considerable time will be dedicated for viewing them, and posters will be on display throughout the conference in the Poster and Exhibit Hall. This is the primary gathering spot where morning, mid-day and afternoon coffee breaks are served, as well as the welcome social and a formal poster session and reception. This allows ample time for visibility, networking and interaction.

Registration is Required: To confirm your poster and have your abstract published, you must register for the conference and pay the applicable fee **by August 9, 2024.** <https://conference.ifas.ufl.edu/flooding/registration-information.php>

Poster Display Specifications

- Posters are on display throughout the symposium.
- Posters are portrait style, limited to a maximum size of 46" tall x 70" wide. *There will be one poster per board *Please do not exceed specified dimensions.**
- Each poster is assigned a number in advance. We place a number on the board, so there is no need to embed a number in your poster design.
- Posters may be affixed using Velcro or pushpins. We provide a limited supply of Velcro.
- The poster session is Wednesday, October 30th from 5pm – 7pm. Presenters should plan to be stationed at their poster from 5:30pm – 6:30pm to answer questions and engage with attendees.

POSTER REMOVAL:	Thursday, October 31, 12:00PM – 1:00PM (<i>Immediately following the closing keynote</i>)
