

Problem Statement: Need for Sanitation Training Targeting Small Processors

- Preliminary knowledge is present, but many lack the foundational knowledge needed to implement sanitation programs
- Regulatory inspections report a lack of training records & lack of established sanitation programs as top deficiencies.




