






#### SB 2080 FFL definition....

- quality landscape that conserve water,
- protect the environment,
- are adaptable to local conditions, and
- **♦ are drought tolerant**. F.S.,Ch.373.185











#### SB 2080 FFL Principles...

- right plant in the right place,
- efficient watering,
- appropriate fertilization,
- mulch,
- attraction of wildlife,
- responsible management of yard pests,
- recycling yard waste,
- reduction of stormwater runoff, and















## **SB 2080 Highlights**

- **♦** Deletes references to "Xeriscape"
- ♦ Homeowner association (HOA) covenants, deed restrictions, and local government ordinances may not prohibit or be enforced so as to prohibit any property owner from implementing Florida-Friendly Landscaping<sup>TM</sup> practices

## **SB 2080 Highlights**

- **♦** Does NOT invalidate HOA architectural Control and Landscape committees
- ◆ Does prohibit any watering mandates that are in violation of Water Management District water use restrictions
- Does not address common areas

# Chapter 482.1562, F.S. Limited certification for urban landscape commercial fertilizer application











#### **F.S. Section 403.933**

- (1) The FDEP, in cooperation with UF/IFAS, shall:
  - (a) Provide training and testing programs in urban landscape best-management practices
  - (b) issue certificates demonstrating satisfactory completion of the training.










### Florida Population 1950-2030









#### URBAN LAND USE IN CENTRAL FLORIDA

This region is projected to have the largest percentage of urban land use (51%) of any region in the state by 2060.







- ◆ 25 to 60% of homeowner water use is for lawn & landscape irrigation
- Improper water use has impacted the source of our drinking water and other ecosystems

#### **SUCCESS STORIES**

- ♦ Ocean Gallery Village Las Palmas St Johns County
- **♦ Low-volume irrigation**
- **♦ Installment of soil moisture sensors**
- ♦ Replacement of difficult-to-maintain turf areas with groundcover

Ten million gallons of water in 2½ years, and \$6,500/year







# Tamarind Village Community Association Broward County (117 Homes)

By implementing FFL Practices, water use was reduced by 6.4 million gallons over 2 yrs (34.1 million gal → 27.7 million gal)

- Water cost savings = \$2.55/1000 g = \$16,320
- ► Fertilizer cost savings = \$12,000
- ► Pesticide cost savings = \$5,000





- **Deletes references to "Xeriscape"**
- **♦** Homeowner association (HOA) covenants, restrictions may not prohibit Florida-Friendly Landscaping<sup>™</sup> practices
- **Does NOT invalidate HOA architectural Control and landscape committees**
- **The law does not allow a homeowner to retrofit their yard by removing turf without HOA's permission**
- **h** There a no government agency that enforces FFL/FYN
