

Instructions for Pre-recorded Talks

8th International Greenhouse Gas & Animal Agriculture Conference

June 5 -10, 2022 | Orlando, Florida, USA

Speaker Registration Deadline: March 4, 2022

We are excited you were selected to give a talk in conjunction with GGAA 2022.

GGAA will feature TWO TYPES of oral presentations:

- 1) In-Person Talks: These will be presented live during a session at GGAA in Orlando, Florida, USA.
- 2) Pre-recorded Talks: These will be pre-recorded in the GGAA virtual studio and viewed on-demand on the virtual platform.

These instructions are for those who will be pre-recording a talk for viewing on the GGAA 2022 virtual platform. To ensure your presentation is available by the conference date, please carefully review and follow these instructions.

<u>REQUIREMENT TO PRESENT</u>: Speakers must register and pay the fee by March 4 to confirm participation as a presenter.

PowerPoint Preparation Instructions:

- All presentations should be created in PowerPoint 16 using WIDESCREEN 16:9 formatting.
- If using graphs or figures, embed them in slides as independent objects; do <u>not</u> dynamically link from other programs. If using video or audio files, save all files along with the PPT file <u>into one folder</u>. (MP4, WMV & Quick Time file formats are supported.)
- Speakers are responsible for infringement penalties if they use copywritten material without permission.
- Disable any automatic advance timer in your PowerPoint file.
- Files are limited to 75 MB or less. Photos for slides may be compressed and saved in a lower resolution to reduce file size.
- When naming your file, save it with your abstract ID, last name and first name [EXAMPLE: 12-Smith-John.ppt.]

Pre-recording Your Presentation:

- Remote speakers must pre-record their talk in the GGAA hosted virtual studio by Friday, May 13. (see link below)
- Pre-recorded talks will be posted on the virtual platform for viewing by remote attendees. By recording, speakers agree to have their presentation video posted on the virtual platform. *This is mandatory to participate.*
- Talks may not exceed 15 minutes. As there is no interactive component for Q&A, it is important to include a CONTACT SLIDE at the end of your talk, so attendees can email you with questions.

Remote Speakers must pre-record their talk no later than Friday, May 13, 2022.

- You must make an advance appointment to pre-record your talk in the GGAA hosted virtual studio.
- o Appointment times fill up quickly, so we recommend you make your reservation well ahead of time.
