

# **What is NRDA?**

---

- A legal process**
- under state and federal laws**
- to determine type and amount of restoration needed to compensate the public for harm to natural resources and their human uses**
- that occurred as a result of an unauthorized release of hazardous substances or oil.**





    - Oil Spill Prevention and Response Act of 1991
    - National Oil and Hazardous Substances Pollution Contingency Plan
  - Comprehensive Environmental Response Compensation, and Liability Act (CERCLA)
  - Superfund Amendments and Reauthorization Act
  - Texas Water Code/ Texas Administrative Code: Title 31 Part 1 Chapter 20
  - Texas Oil Spill Prevention and Response Act
- **Texas state trustees**
    - Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ)
    - Texas General Land Office (GLO)
    - Texas Parks and Wildlife Department (TPWD).
  - **federal trustees**
    - National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA)

# Restoration hierarchy

---

- Clean up does not equal restoration
  - Emergency restoration
  - Primary restoration
  - Compensatory restoration



# NRDA Restoration Projects in Texas

- **150 superfund sites**
- **41 settlements**
- **55 completed restoration projects**
- **\$32 million projects planned/implemented**
- **\$25.8 million funding available, not including BP oil spill funds**
- **43 cases pending**
- **Partnering leverages additional funds**



# Accomplishments

---

- **Offshore artificial reefs:**
  - **Galveston**
    - New 160-ac concrete pyramid deployments
    - 80-ac sunken ship deployment
  - **Freeport**
    - Concrete deployment within 160 ac George Vancouver (Liberty Ship) Artificial Reef
  - **Matagorda**
    - New reef concrete deployment



# Accomplishments

---

- **Oyster Reefs:**
  - 11 acres constructed
  - Others in Matagorda Bay, Lavaca Bay, Corpus Christi Bay
- **Recreational/Human Use Projects :**
  - 3 boat ramps
  - 3 fishing piers
  - beach pavilions and shade structures
  - Wildlife viewing platforms



# Accomplishments

---

- **Estuarine Wetlands:**

- 735 acres constructed
- 2165 acres enhanced
- 322 acres acquired



# Accomplishments

---

- **Freshwater Wetlands:**
  - 197 acres constructed
  - 1505 acres enhanced
  - 908 acres acquired
- **Riparian and Bottomland Forests:**
  - 55 acres constructed
  - 1740 acres protected





# Accomplishments

  - 17,000 acres Powderhorn Ranch




# Accomplishments – Bahia Grande Restoration Project
