DDT Contamination in Southern California

- 80 tons of DDT dumped by Montrose Chemical.
- Entered the marine ecosystem through sewer outfalls.
- Impacted top avian predators such as the bald eagle.

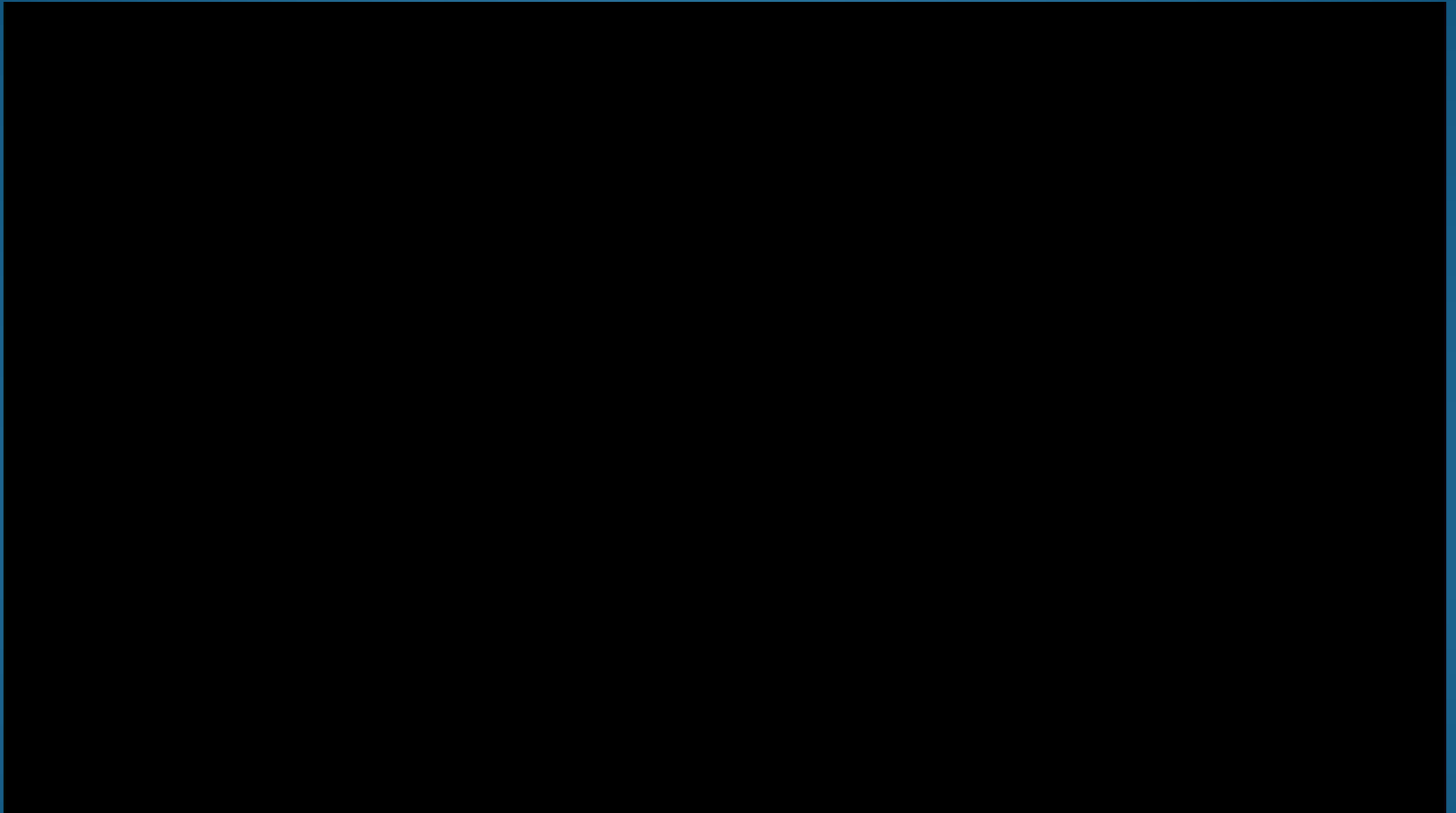

Accomplishments of Bald Eagle Restoration Program



- The island's first “second-generation” eaglet.
- Currently 60+ resident bald eagles.
- 15 breeding pairs resulting in 16 fledged chicks.
- EagleCams resulting in 4 million viewers.

STRAW — Students and Teachers Restoring a Watershed

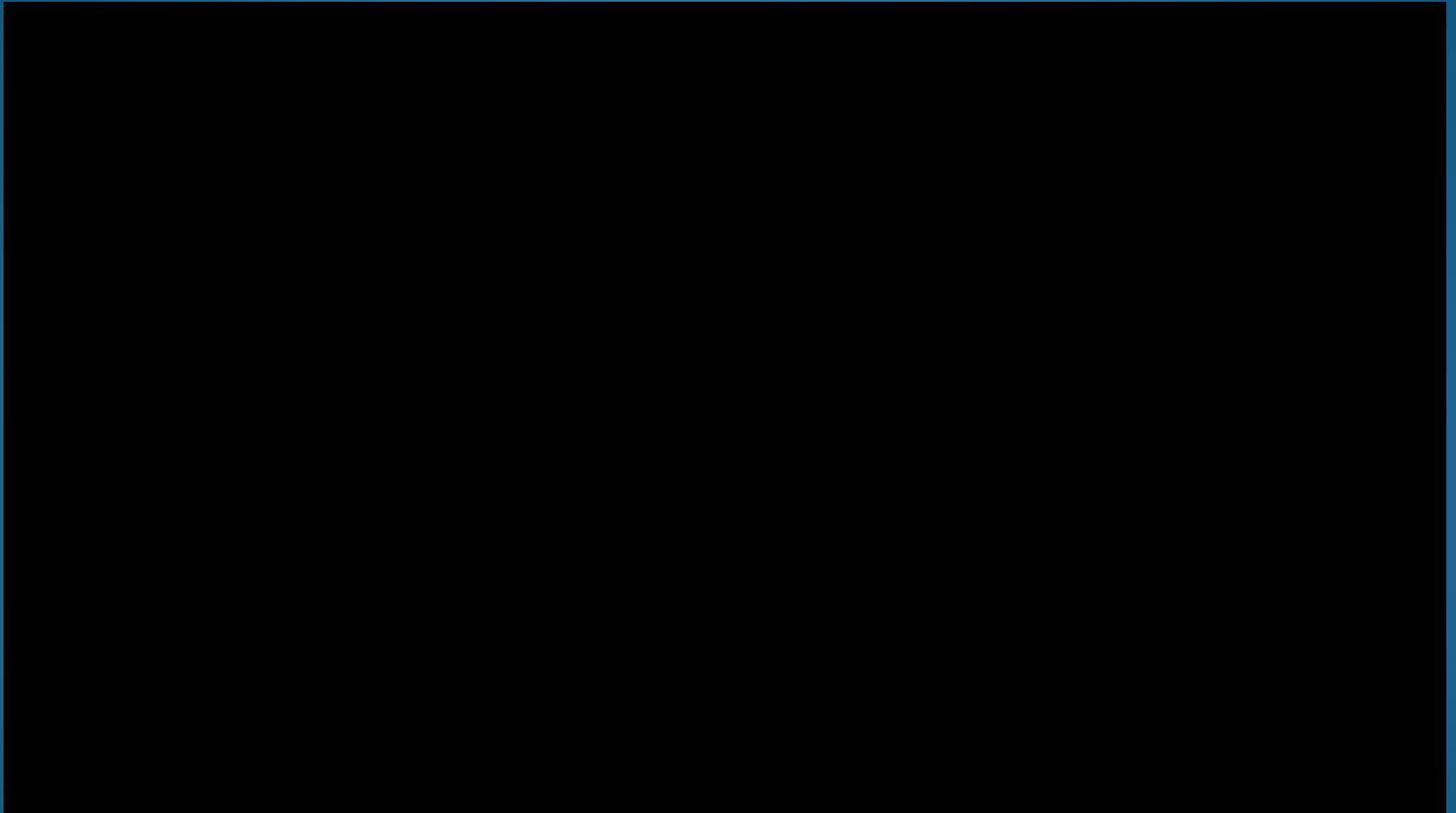

- 29 miles of riparian habitat restored
- Expansion of CA freshwater shrimp range
- 22+ species of rare and endangered birds returned

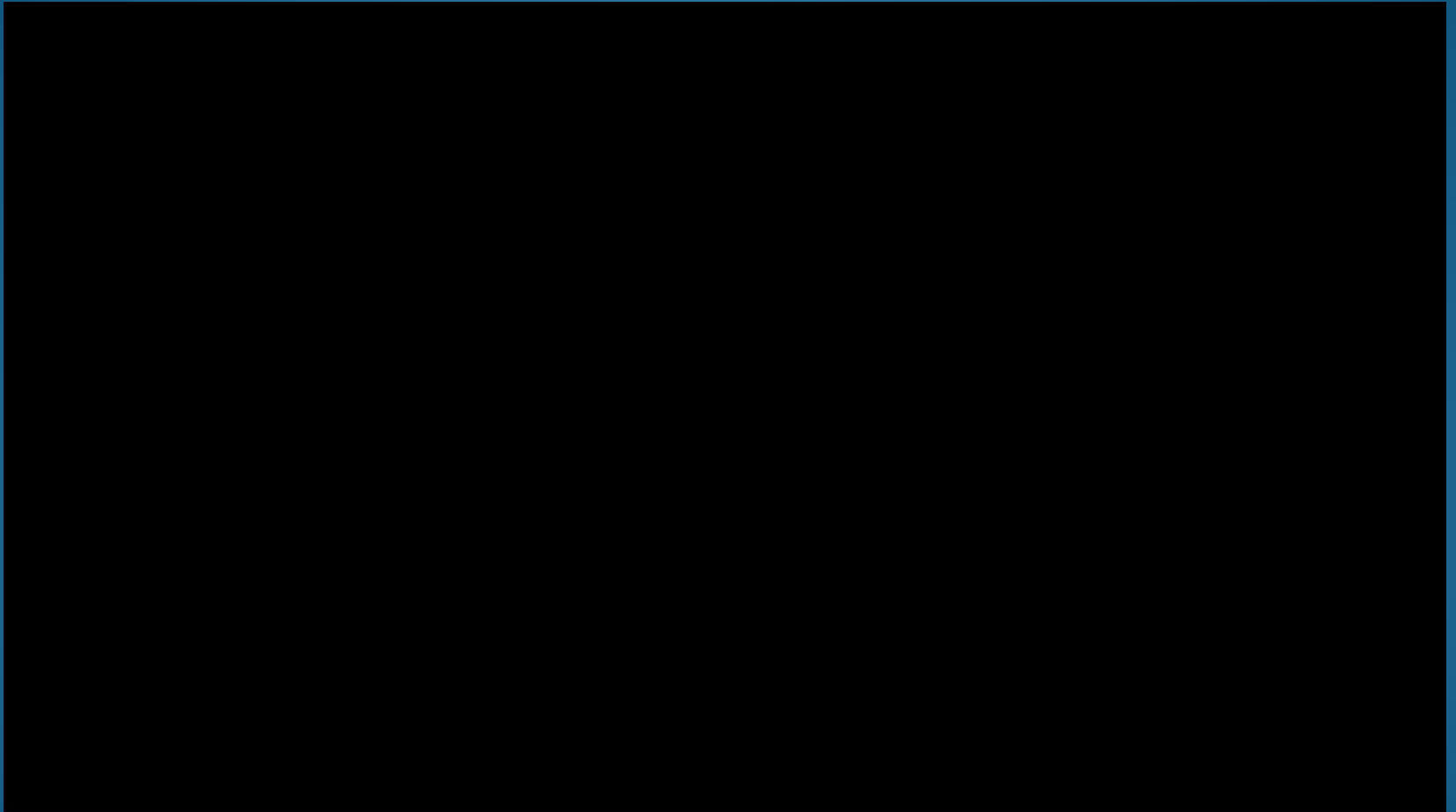

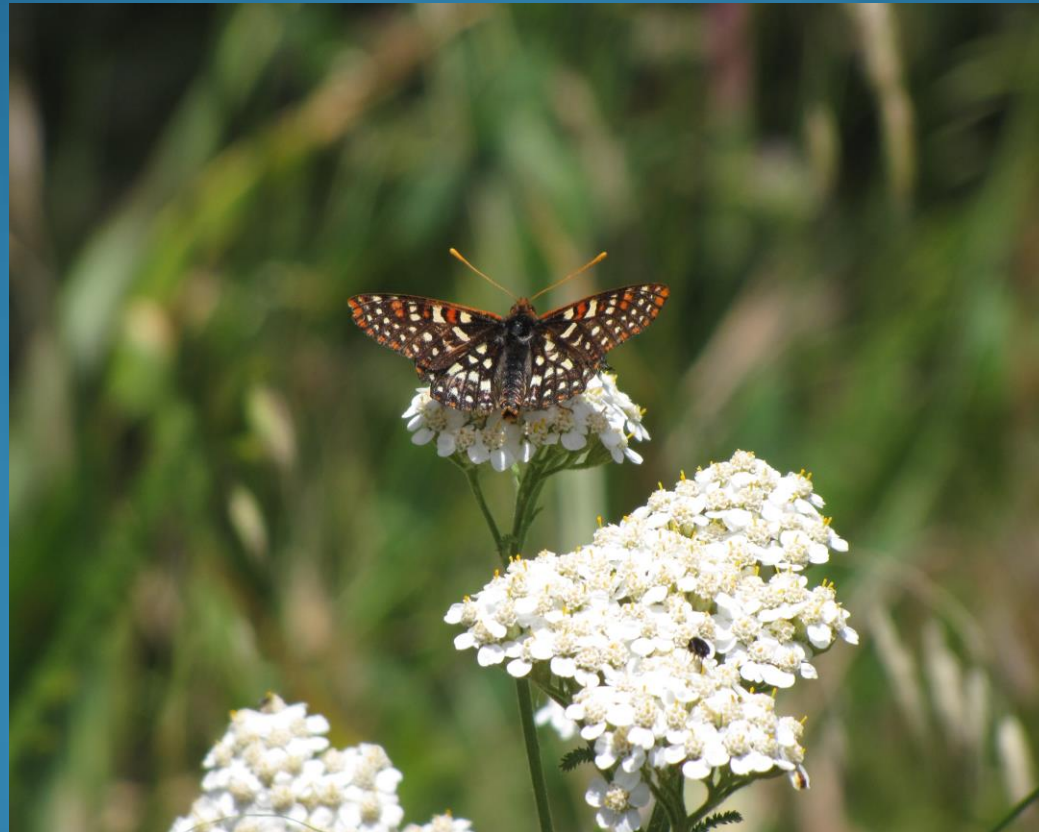
