



Louisiana Coastal Area (LCA) Near-Term Plan



Section 1019 of WRRDA 2014

Amends Section 7007 of WRDA 2007 to allow:

- Use of NFS in-kind credit for studies or projects authorized in Title VII of WRDA 2007 (LCA Projects)
- Transfer of "excess credit" for a study or project to be applied toward the non-federal cost share of another Title VII study or project
