

- Field/lab notes & logs
- Raw instrument data
- Voucher specimens
- Video or audio recordings
- Photos
- Sample tracking records
- Training records

Field & Lab QC Data

- Instrument calibration records
- Field QC check findings, reports, forms, logs/notes
- Lab QC sample results
- Audit reports

Procedural tools

- Tailored to method, program and/or project
- Guidelines, SOPs, Variablespecific tables, checklists
- Sampling/monitoring plan
- Sample location maps
- Field guides, lists, keys, code definitions

- **Processing**: procedures for all data types*
 - <u>Transcription</u>: procedures to transfer data from hard-copy forms to database
 - Review: automation of data verification & validation procedures
 - Certification: procedures to certify the validated database
- Analysis: data reduction, metric calculation, data manipulation (e.g., models, statistics)

*e.g., field observations, field instrument data, GPS, digital photos, samples & vouchers, lab results and QC data

Great Lakes Data Preservation & Archiving


- Metadata standards: templates & content standards to apply
- Metadata creation: documentation for all data, including QC data
- **Archiving**: procedures for archiving all data, reports, & quality documentation
